HOW WELL DO YOU KNOW ELVERSON BOROUGH?

I was surprised that so many Elverson (and Morgantown) residents knew the location of the historic farmhouse pictured in the February 2016 issue of the Elverson Borough Newsletter. Ten people contacted me to let me know that the house was located on Rte 401 just east of its intersection with Rte 82, at 33 East Conestoga Road. Winners are Roseann Thomas, John Morrow, Linda Godschall, Judy Williams, John Mohl, Coleen Biffen, Cynthia Anton, Shirley Colyer, Anna May Hoffman and Ginger Smith. Congratulations. I have delivered an Elverson Day tee shirt to each one.

This historic farm house was originally built in the 1890's and only contained the east (stone) portion of the house, which was constructed as a bank house as it was built into the bank of a hill. Two additions have been added to the house – one between 1920 and 1940, with plaster and lathe walls, and the other shortly before the current owners, the Tshudy family, purchased it in 2001. The Tshudy's have remodeled and repaired it. Many of those who identified this picture mentioned that one of its former owners were the Meissner's, who sold it to build the house next door, where they now live. Some also noted that the owner of this house used to walk a Saint Bernard through Summerfield. David Tshudy told me that this dog was their beloved Kaiser, who passed away late last year. One person thought the home used to house an insurance company. Since David is researching the history of his home, I am sure he would welcome any information you would like to share with him. You can relay the information through me.

Due to the alertness and knowledge of many Elverson residents, I have distributed a lot of Elverson Day tee shirts recently and now have only three size Large shirts left – all of which are yellow. 


