The monthly meeting of the Elverson Borough Council was held on Tuesday, December 1, 2015 and called to order at 7:00 PM by Shirley Crehan who led the Pledge of Allegiance.

ATTENDANCE:

MINUTES:

Motion was made by Merle Stoltzfus and seconded by Doug Hoskins to accept the November minutes as submitted. Motion carried by all.

TREASURERS REPORT:

Motion was made by Dwight Frizen and seconded by Bob French to accept the December Treasurers Report and pay bills as presented. Motion carried by all.

BUILDING, GROUNDS, STREETS AND LIGHTS:

Bob French mentioned that there has been progress made on the repairs to the walls and ceiling at Borough Hall. Bob said that there will be tack boards installed in the office and entry way areas and he has also started the process for getting bids for painting.

Doug Hoskins mentioned that a pipe was repaired along Brick Lane.

Doug Hoskins discussed the quote for the recommended repairs to the playground equipment.

Doug Hoskins asked Council if there was any further contact with PennDot in regard to a plan for storm sewer and road repairs on Route 23. Council was not aware of any recent discussion with PennDot at this time.

ENGINEERING:

Mark Stabolepszy reviewed his report with Council and discussed SSM's 2016 rates.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Motion was made by Doug Hoskins and seconded by Jack Stewart to adopt the Elverson Borough 2106 Budget, motion carried by all.

Shirley Crehan reviewed the 2016 Meeting dates with Council Members. Council agreed that the 2016 meeting dates would be the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM, with the exception of the January meeting, which will be held on Monday, January 4, 2016 at 7:00 PM and will include the reorganization meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Council discussed the Turnpike Widening Project and the need for sound barriers. Merle Stoltzfus will draft a letter to the Turnpike Commission, on behalf of Borough Council, in favor of sound barriers. Shirley Crehan, Council President, will sign the letter.

Merle Stoltzfus informed Council that he received a phone call from a homeowner who is concerned about storm water run-off from a property located in the Borough. The homeowner said that this storm water has caused his driveway to deteriorate. Merle is looking into this concern.

Jack Stewart made a motion to adjourn, motion seconded by Bob French. Motion carried by all.
