

PENNDOT MAIN STREET (SR23) PROJECT SCHEDULED TO BEGIN ON FEBRUARY 23, 2019

PennDot will have a presence back in the Borough, starting on Monday 2/25/19. During that week they will be installing some short storm sewer runs on the north side of the roadway (where the parking stalls are located along SR 23 WB). That work will be done using a daytime flagger pattern.

The detour will be reinstalled on Monday 3/4/19 and it will follow the same route as last year....SR 401 to SR 345, back to SR 23. Westbound SR 23 traffic will still be able to travel completely thru town. Eastbound SR 23 traffic will not be allowed between Chestnut and South Pine Streets. Both intersections will remain open and cross traffic will be allowed to cross over Main Street.

There will be work in the actual intersection of Chestnut Street and SR23 to be completed, so there will be some daytime delays as PennDot installs the new storm pipe, and removes the existing roadway, curb and sidewalk.

PennDot will place message boards out approximately two weeks in advance of the March 4, 2019 detour.
