MINUTES:

Motion made by Laura Pennza and seconded by Julie Duffy to accept the February 3, 2026, Council meeting minutes as submitted. Motion carried by all.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

TREASURERS REPORT:

Motion made by Turner Stoltzfus and seconded by Julie Duffy to accept the Treasurers Report and pay the bills as presented. Motion carried by all.

PRESIDENTS REPORT:

Dennis Kurtz discussed the landscaping bid which was received from Heilner Landscaping. Motion made by Laura Pennza and seconded by Turner Stoltzfus to award the bid for the Borough's Landscaping Services, as submitted to Heilner Landscaping Co., Inc. Motion carried by all.

Cindy Franchitti stated that Saturday, April 18th is the tentative date for the skate park grand opening. Cindy stated she contacted PP&L for a cost to hang banners along Main Street; she is waiting on PP&L to get back to her.

Laura Pennza asked if there will be a Spring Newsletter. Lorrie Stolz stated yes, she spoke with Esther Prosser and Esther advised her that the cutoff date to get information submitted for the Spring Newsletter is April 15th.

Julie Duffy mentioned there is a pothole forming on S. Pine St. Lorrie stated she will contact Tim McEwen to get this filled in.
